



# CARVE A PINEAPPLE JACK-O-LANTERN FOR HALLOWEEN!

## PINEAPPLE JACK-O-LANTERN Carving Directions

### STEP 1: Getting Ready

You will need a pineapple that measures a minimum of 5" wide and 7" tall. You will also need a serrated knife, a spoon, a cutting board, a pair of scissors, and tape or toothpicks. Use a pineapple corer if you have one.

### STEP 2: Cutting the Pineapple

Cut the bottom of the pineapple off using the serrated knife, then cut around the inside edge of the pineapple, keeping the walls of the pineapple about 1" thick for support.

### STEP 3: Hollowing Out the Pineapple

Use the knife and spoon to remove the pineapple flesh, including the core, until nice and clean. Place the pineapple flesh in a bowl to eat—something you can't do with a pumpkin!

### STEP 4: Preparing the Template

Pick your favorite face from the templates provided in this worksheet, and carefully cut out each piece of the face using scissors. Use tape or toothpicks to attach each piece onto the pineapple.

### STEP 5: Cutting out the Eyes & Mouth

Using the serrated knife, carefully cut out the face, using each piece of the template as guides. When done, remove the templates, tape, and/or toothpicks.

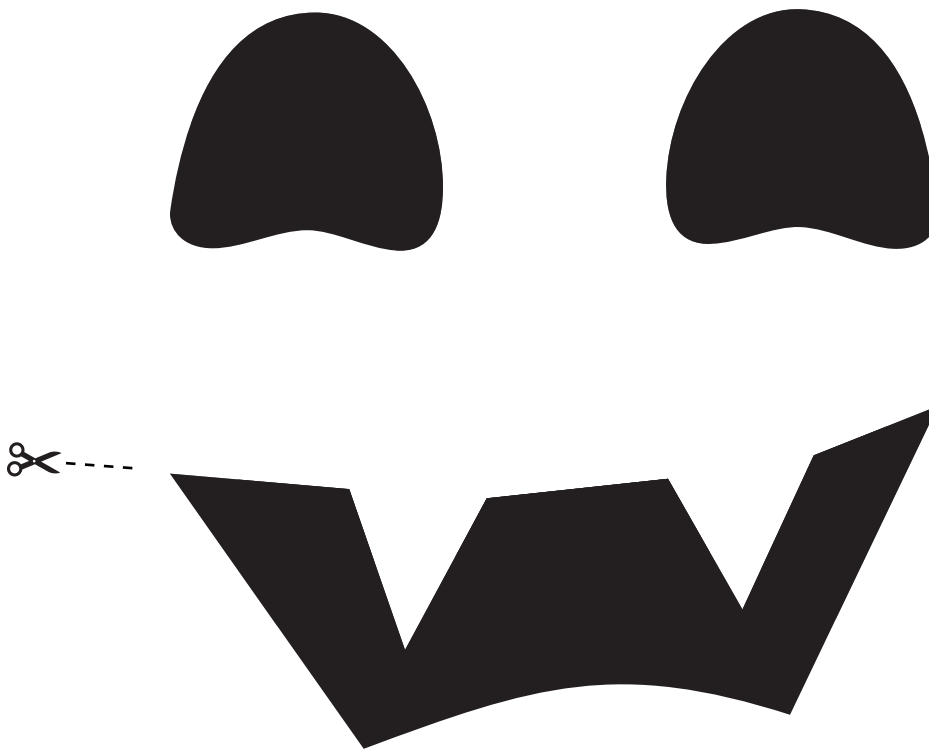
### STEP 6: Enjoy!

Place the finished pineapple on a plate and enjoy the look and taste of your creation! When it gets dark, place a lit LED candle on the plate under the pineapple Jack-O-Lantern!
