#### **FUN FACT:**


Banana plants require intensive, individual care from Dole Bananeros. Stems are ready for harvest after about 9-months, averaging 150-200 fingers and weighing 85 to 100 pounds each. It takes two people to harvest one stem of bananas. One worker nicks the stalk with a machete, and another worker catches it on his shoulder. He wears a thick, comfortable cushion on his shoulder to soften the heavy load and protect the bananas from getting bruised.
